- Hollingsworth has the potential to build an over 500k square foot building, this is a great potential spec building for Loudon County to market
- Project Panda Centre 75, \$240 Million Capital Investment, over 200 high quality jobs averaging salaries of \$60k and up, we offered incentives to locate, expect the agreement to purchase the land next month
- TVA Site Development Grant for the Pad site is still on hold
- Project Aerie Airplane Site
- Project Walking Horse Solar Farm with LUB
- Project Bio anaerobic digestor system, bio-products/gas, provides natural gas, prospecting across from Primient

Blair Patterson Sitzlar gave the following updates:

- LCEDA hosted a successful Education and Industry Summit in August, both local school systems and TCAT attended and presented to the local industry community
